

COMMUNITY AGREEMENT

To ensure a safe and respectful space for everyone during our conference, we ask that you observe the following rules and agreements.



Photos, video, and audio recordings

Photos, videos, and audio recordings are only permitted for accredited journalists and photographers. These individuals will be identified accordingly and will be familiar with the security requirements.

At the registration desk/information desk, you may request a badge if you do not want to be photographed.

Preserving the anonymity of participants

During our conference, the Chatham House Rule applies to some formats in order to maintain the anonymity of participants who express their opinions.

This means that content may be shared, but it is prohibited to disclose the source of the content or the identities of participants, speakers, or discussion partners.

The event rooms where this will be enforced are marked accordingly, and the moderator will remind participants of this rule at the beginning of each session.

Respectful interaction

Treat each other with respect. Aggressive or discriminatory language, sexual and physical harassment, and intimidation will not be tolerated. Anyone who engages in such behavior will be asked to leave the conference. The house rules apply here.

If you notice such behavior, please report it to the information desk or our designated awareness team. We take your information very seriously. It will be treated confidentially, and an appropriate response will be made with the aim of ensuring the safety and well-being of everyone at the conference.

In the event of any violation of the above rules/agreements, we will exercise our domiciliary rights, and you will be subject to expulsion from the event.
