How to come to the Counter-Summit in Hendaye:

The counter-summit's camp will be located next to the Pierre et Vacances centre, Le Domaine de Bordaberry -Route De La Corniche, Lieu Dit Bordaberry, 64122 Urrugne.

There are several solutions to reach the location from France:

From Paris-Montparnasse : 1 train every 2 hours approx. From 7.47am until 5.47pm (Journey duration: 4h40).

From Toulouse : 1 train every 2 hours approx. From 6.30am until 4.45pm (Journey: 5h20).

From Bordeaux : 1 train every hour approx. From 5.20am until 8.02pm (Journey: 2h40)

From Marseille : 1 train every hour approx. From 5.14am until 2.57pm (Journey: 9h00)

From Hendaye's station: take shuttle 20 to Ciboure-Saint-Jean de Luz. Get off at Abadia stop, then take shuttle 6 to Hendaye-Haïçabia terminus. Walk 100m on the road to the cornice, with the sea on your left. Then take the first road on the right to enter the Domaine de la Bordaberry.

From Hendaye-Les 2 Jumeaux's station: directly take shuttle 6 to Hendaye-Haïçabia terminus. Walk 100m on the road to the cornice, with the sea on your left. Then take the first road on the right to enter the Domaine de la Bordaberry.

Life at the Counter-Summit:

We will have several large areas distributed throughout the camp where you can set up your tents and camping equipment as well as a car park for your vehicles (we are in the process of determining its location).
